Tournament Rules

- RULES:** These are the rules for the tournament. All decisions of Tournament Officials are final. Any violation of these rules or State Water Patrol regulations will result in disqualification possibly from future events. Knowledge of all Sunnyhill, Inc. rules is the responsibility of the participant and by signing the entry form the participant waives any legal venue and agrees with all Sunnyhill, Inc. decisions.
- ELIGIBILITY:** All individuals 18 years of age or older unless participating with parent or guardian, who have paid their proper entry fees. Entry form must be completely filled out by both participants. We reserve the right to deny any entries we feel are not in the interest of Sunnyhill Inc.
- ENTRY FEES:** Team \$100 per boat.
- TOURNAMENT HOURS:** You must check-in at 6 a.m. for the tournament. We reserve the right to change the tournament date or hours if necessary. Tournament will be re-announced before take-off.
- TAKE OFF:** Will be in the order in which they were received. The take off site area will be the official check-out and check-in area. Red boat numbers assigned must be displayed during the tournament hours. Live wells and kill switches will be inspected during take-off.
- TEAM:** Teams consist of 2 members who fish together. If one member cannot fish, the other team member may use an alternate or fish by themselves.
- TACKLE & EQUIPMENT:** Only artificial lures or baits may be used. All bass must be caught alive on a rod and reel during the tournament hours from a boat in a sporting manner. No trolling.
- BOATS & MOTORS:** Boats 15 feet or longer, with properly working aerated live-wells and kill switch. All boats must meet B.I.A., U.S. Coast Guard and State Water Patrol regulations.
- SAFETY & SPORTSMANSHIP:** Safe boating and fishing practices must be observed at all times. Life jackets **MUST BE WORN** any time the combustion motor is running. Kill switches **MUST BE ATTACHED** to driver anytime the combustion motor is running. Each contestant is expected to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy, safety and conservation. No alcoholic beverages, stimulants or depressants allowed in the boats. **NO** hole sitting or holding fishing spot for another fisherman or contestants.
- PERMITTED FISHING LOCATIONS:** Anywhere on the tournament water except within 50 yards of another contestant's boat, or the take-off area inside the marker buoys. All fishing must be from the boat. Contestants can lock into other pools by boat. No contestant may leave the boat to land a fish and no trailing. Any rule changes at the tournament site will override any written tournament rule.
- SCORING:** Largemouth, Kentucky and Smallmouth Bass will be weighed. Only 5 fish per boat may be weighed-in. All fish will be measured on a flat BPS metal keeper board. All fish will be measured with mouth closed and with a pinched or fanned tail. Any short fish presented for weigh-in will cause 2 lbs. to be deducted from the total weight. Dead fish will receive a 1 lb. deduction per fish and only 2 dead fish per boat. No culling inside the marker buoys of the take-off cove or weigh-in area. We reserve the right to change the amount of fish per boat if necessary. Length limit for the lake will apply.
- WEIGH-IN:** Will begin at the end of the tournament hours. No fish will be weighed until then. You must be at scales with fish, 1/2 hour after check-in. One team member must be present with slip to verify weight during weigh-in. Weighing-in more than 5 fish, is cause for disqualification.
- PROTESTS:** Must be filed in writing within 10 minutes after weigh-in and signed. Person or persons, making protest will be responsible for payment of test. Random testing may be given by tournament officials to any contestant, with or without a protest being filed.
- TIES:** Ties will be broken by earliest entry received.
- CHECK-IN & LATE PENALTY:** All boats must check-in; any boat weighing in fish that did not check-in will be disqualified. Late penalty is 1 lb. per minute up to 10 minutes. The check-in is the same area as the take-off area. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- PAYBACK:** See prizes.
- CHALLENGE RULE:** Short or dead fish may be challenged. We will stop weigh-in and make every effort to determine if the fish is short or dead.
- TOURNAMENT MEETING:** 10 minutes before take-off, we will go over the basic rules and tournament hours before take-off.
- TOURNAMENT CANCELLATION:** If cancelled due to reasons of safety, high water, etc., entry fees will be transferred. **NO REFUNDS.**
- Sunnyhill reserves the right to award prorated prizes.
- Any person who has been awarded \$2000 or more in prize money from 2009 tournament season is ineligible to win prize money.
